BACKGROUND:

On May 13, 2009 at the Fiscal Year 2009-2010 Budget Workshop, the Board of Supervisors requested a list of all Federal Recovery Act Stimulus Grants departments are pursuing along with how much total funding is available.

DISCUSSION:

The following list illustrates the Federal Recovery Act Grants the Probation Department applied for, the total availability amounts, and the estimated award dates.

- 1. Recovery Act National and Local Youth Mentoring Initiative Grants Projects have either national or local scope. \$97 million total funding available for both categories. Amount for each category yet to be determined.
 - Competitive application submitted by Probation on April 20, 2009
 - o Applied for a project with local scope
 - Probation applied for \$500,000 total (\$125,000 per year during FY 09-10, FY 10-11, FY 11-12 & FY 12-13) to fund a Youth Detention Facility reentry mentoring program with Youth Connections Unlimited
 - Estimated award date would be the first quarter of Fiscal Year 2009-2010

2. Recovery Act Edward Byrne Memorial Competitive Grant - \$120 million total nationwide for all 8 categories

- Competitive grant application submitted by Probation April 27, 2009
 - Category II: Providing for Funding of Neighborhood Probation and Parole Officers
- Probation applied for \$881,728 total for FY 09-10 & FY 10-11 to fund 2.0 Sr. DPO positions in the Adult Field Sex Offender Unit
- Estimated award date would be the first quarter of Fiscal Year 2009-2010

3. Recovery Act Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant - Approximately \$90.16 million allocated to local agencies in California

- Probation applied for the allocation to local agencies (not competitive)
- Grant application submitted by Probation May 15, 2009
- Probation applied for \$1,936,990 total for FY 09-10 & FY 10-11 to fund 1.0 Supervising Probation Officer, 4.0 Sr. Deputy Probation Officers, and 1.0 Deputy Probation Officer in the Adult Field Gang Suppression Unit
- Estimated award date would be the first quarter of Fiscal Year 2009-2010
