## **BACKGROUND**

At the May 14, 2009, Budget Workshop, the Department of Human Assistance (DHA) presented information about proposed reductions in the Department to meet Fiscal Year 2009-10 General Fund allocation targets. During the workshop, Supervisor MacGlashan requested that DHA report back on which DHA facilities could be eliminated or consolidated.

## **DISCUSSION**

The Department already has taken significant measures to eliminate and consolidate several facilities in efforts to reduce its operating costs and mitigate layoffs and the loss of direct client services. These efforts include the elimination of five facilities in Fiscal Year 2009-10. In addition, subject to Board approval later this month, DHA will propose the early termination of the lease for our Elk Grove bureau.

For Fiscal Year 2009-10, DHA will have eliminated 25 percent of its leased facilities. The savings generated by eliminating these six leases (out of DHA's 24 current leases) have already been assumed for our Fiscal Year 2009-10 budget.

While the loss of these leases will generate significant savings for the Department, the elimination of these facilities will impact the clients served and the staff operating from these locations. The Department is making every effort to mitigate the impact on client service delivery and is conducting Meet and Confer sessions with the bargaining units representing the impacted DHA staff.

Depending on the implications of the State Budget, the Department may consider the elimination of additional facilities in Fiscal Year 2009-10. In this event, DHA will notify the Board of proposals to exercise the County's option for early lease termination of DHA facilities.
