BACKGROUND

During the June 11, 2009 Budget Hearing, the Department of Health and Human Services was requested to report back on the possibility of First Five funding for In-Home Supportive Services (IHSS) for cases of children 0-5 years of age.

DISCUSSION

The department has met with First 5 staff and reviewed the process to apply for First 5 funding. An application for funding will be submitted to First Five for children's IHSS cases ages 0-5 years of age. Currently, IHSS has 84 cases with a total of 10,727 hours per month for children aged 0-5 years of age. The annual cost is \$1,338,730 and based on 19%, the County cost is \$254,360.
