The requested information is provided as well as the timetable for the opening of additional service centers.

DISCUSSION

The timetable for opening additional service centers is outlined as follows:

These schedules are predicated on a number of variables including, site selection and lease negotiation conducted by the Department of Facilities, Planning, Architecture and Real Estate (FPARE), and construction/remodeling of required tenant improvements performed by property owners. Sites have been selected for Fair Oaks/Orangevale and North Area Service Center. We are working to incorporate the North Service Center into the Sheriff Northwest Station House project. Sites have not been selected for Arden Arcade/Carmichael/Old Foothill Farms or South Sacramento/Vineyard. A generic program and scope of work has been developed for the community centers that will be used by the specific land owners to design and construct tenant improvements.
