BACKGROUND:

This is in response to your Board's request at the Final Budget Hearing on September 6, 2006 to report back on the highway maintenance projects funded with the additional Proposition 42 funds.

DISCUSSION:

With the recent availability of approximately \$8.6 million GTIP (Proposition 42) funds for the maintenance of County roadways, Sacramento County Department of Transportation (SacDOT) is proposing to resurface various residential neighborhoods within the County in fiscal year 2006/07. These residential neighborhoods were approved by your Board in June 2006 as candidate locations in need of paving in the 2006 Maintenance & Operations (M&O) Program Guide. We will be scheduling meetings with each Board members staff within the next two weeks to discuss the proposal and finalize the neighborhood paving locations from this list.

After the locations are finalized, SacDOT will proceed with the development of project and contract and bring it to your Board for advertisement in January 2007. Construction of the project is scheduled to start in spring 2007. If any of the proposed contract work can be done by Force Account with County forces, we will be exploring opportunities to have that accomplished before the start of the 2006 rainy season.
