

Total Population Overview




AB 109 Realignment: Community Supervision




Adult Probation Crime Types




% of Arrestees Testing Positive for Drugs by Offense



Sacramento Male Arrestees Testing Positive For Any Drug by Year




2012: 78 % of Sacramento arrestees tested positive for drugs

Methamphetamine Use: Location Comparison


2012: Male Arrestees Testing Positive for Methamphetamine
